Minimum System Requirements

Processor	Intel Core processor or AMD equivalents

■ Installation

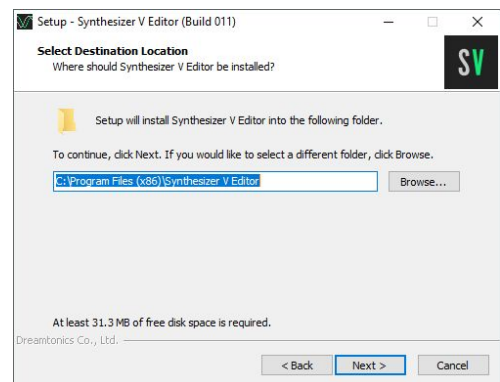
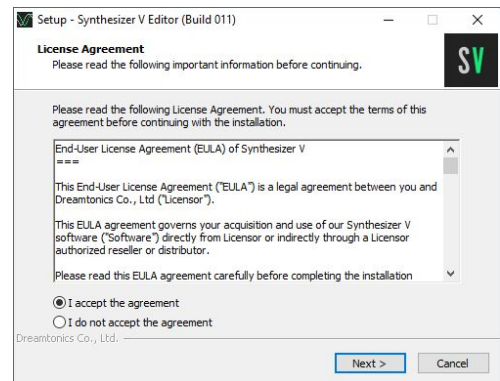
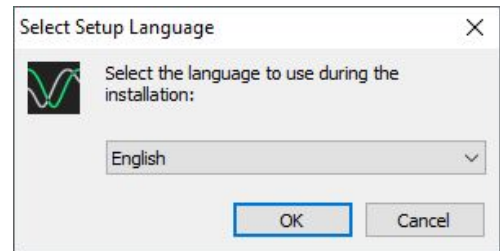
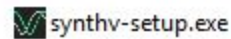
1. Double click the setup program to start.
2. If your preferred language isn't English, select a language for the setup wizard. The selected language will also be the default language for the program installed.

Press "OK" to continue.

3. Please read the End-User License Agreement (EULA) carefully and continue the installation by selecting "I accept the agreement" if you agree with the terms.

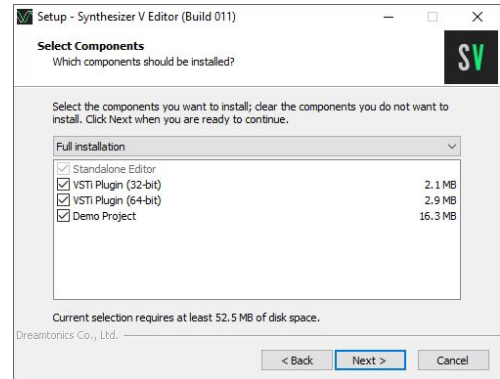
Press "Next" to continue.

4. Select the destination directory for the main program.

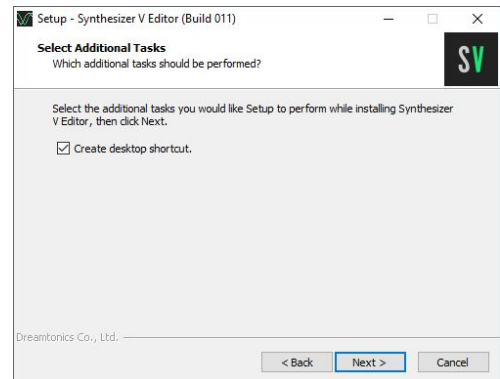


5. You may customize the components to be installed (except the standalone editor).

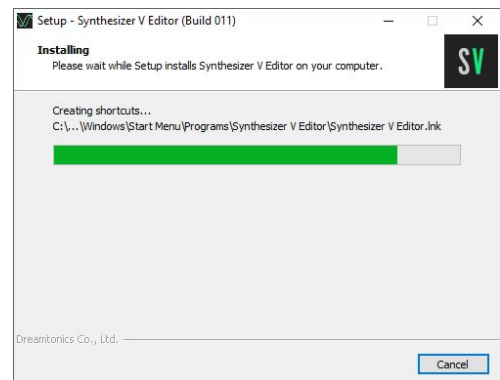
Note that VSTi plugins are installed to Program Files\Steinberg\VSTPlugins. You may need to manually configure your digital audio workstation (DAW) software to discover the plugin.



6. Optionally, you may choose to create a shortcut to start Synthesizer V Editor from desktop.



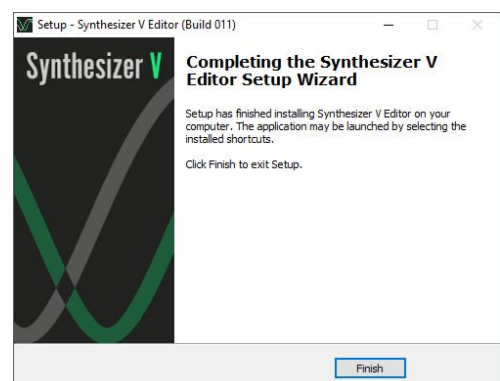
7. Press next and the setup wizard will start copying over the files and applying various configurations.



8. The installation is completed.

Press "Finish" to quit.

Note: to use Synthesizer V, you also need to install at least one voice database, which is sold or offered separately from this product.



■ Activation

1. Using Synthesizer V requires activation. Before activation, a reminder will show up upon startup.

Press “Enter Registration Code...” if you decide to activate Synthesizer V and have purchased a registration code, or wait for 10 seconds and continue your evaluation.

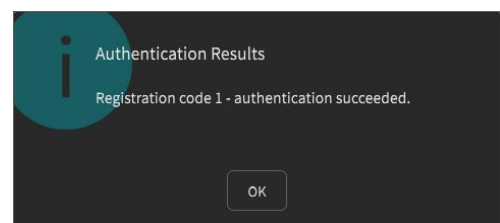
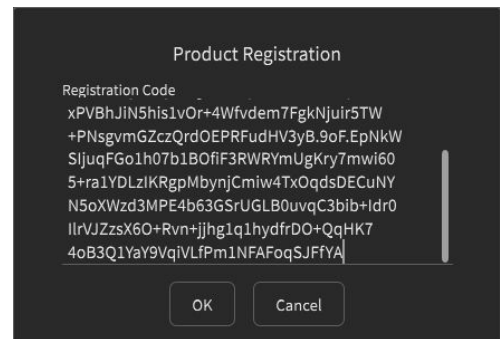
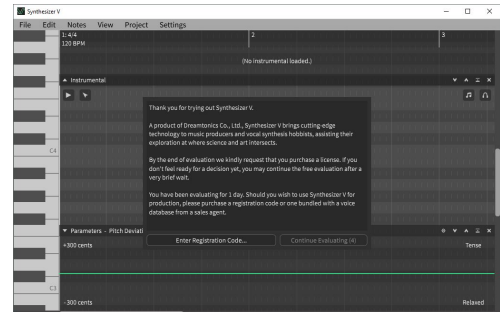
Note that voice databases may require separate activation before use.

2. Make sure you have internet connection when activating a product. Then, copy and paste the registration code into the popup dialog and press “OK”.

You may enter multiple registration codes at once if you have purchased one or more voice databases. Separate the registration codes by starting a new line.

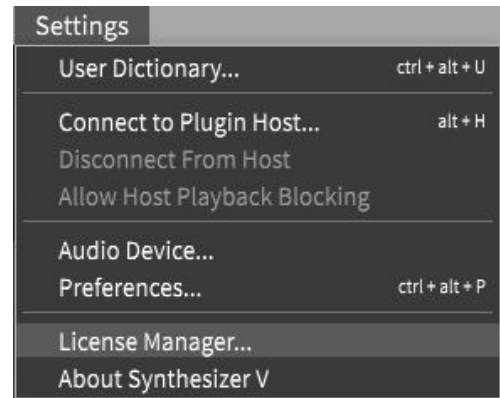
3. The following message contains the result for each registration code entered.

Each registration code can be used on a maximum of 3 devices at any time. Activation will fail if the number of registered devices exceeds this limit. In that case, you need to first deactivate the product on one of the devices.

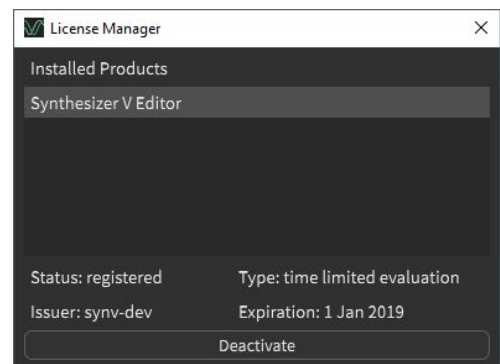


■ Deactivation

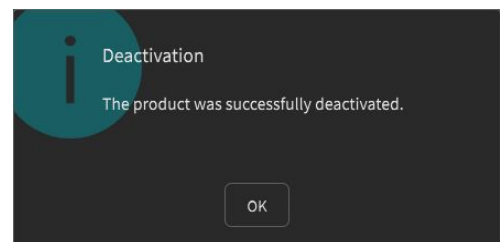
1. To deactivate Synthesizer V Editor or any of the installed voice databases, start the standalone editor and go to "Settings -> License Manager..."



2. Make sure you have internet connection when deactivating a product. Select the product to be deactivated and press "Deactivate" button in the bottom.

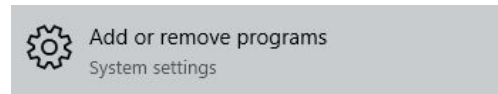


3. The following message displays the result for deactivation.

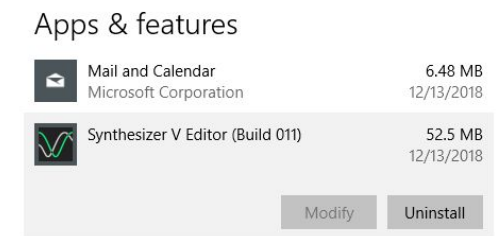


■ Uninstalling

1. Before uninstalling Synthesizer V, please first deactivate all products registered to the device.
Launch “Apps & features” in Windows settings.
2. In the list of applications, navigate to Synthesizer V Editor and press “Uninstall”.



3. Confirm the operation by pressing “Yes”.



4. Synthesizer V Editor and optional components including the VSTi plugins and demo projects are removed.

The uninstaller for Synthesizer V Editor will not remove any voice database.
